THIRD PARTY (PUBLIC) LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR CLUBS & TEAMS

This insurance cover is arranged for 'non-profit making' clubs and teams. Club Secretaries are reminded that 'commercially named' clubs and teams must ensure that they operate on a non-profit making basis and are financially independent of any commercial businesses that may provide support to them. Clubs or teams operating as a commercial business are required to make their own arrangements for commercial liability cover.

All Clubs, Teams and Associations in England other than school clubs are automatically covered for Public Liability Insurance, with an indemnity limit of **£5,000,000** upon payment of the Club Affiliation Fee to British Cycling. Clubs in Scotland and Wales and school clubs are covered by the same policy upon payment of the appropriate Club Third Party Insurance fee. The following liability insurance policy cover is currently in force and renewable on 30th November each year.

Public Liability : **Policy No. - 43UKC18281** Insurer : **ACE Insurance**

Scope of Cover : The policy indemnifies the club / team in respect of its **legal liability for accidental loss or damage to Third Party Property or accidental bodily injury or death to Third Party Persons.**

Limit of Indemnity : £5,000,000 any one incident

Subject to the normal terms and conditions of the Insurer's standard Public Liability Insurance Policy, it indemnifies:

1. **The Club** against claims brought by non-members and invitees;
2. **Officials of the Club**, who act on the Club's specific instructions during their term of office, against claims, as follows :
 - (a) Actions brought by non-members who have been invited (prior to possible membership) to take part in the Club's activities, for example, Club runs, social activities etc., for injuries sustained and damage to Third Party Property, sustained during participation.
 - (b) Actions brought against the Club or its elected officials who have carried out the Club's instructions, including the hire, rent or loan of premises at the instructions of the Club Committee. Such instructions should in all cases comply with the decision given by the Club Committee.
3. **Individuals** who have been invited to participate in Club activities as invitees and are not already covered by any other Insurance.

The following exclusion clauses apply :

- i) Competitive Events - (Road Races, Circuit Races, Time Trials, Track Meetings, Mountain Bike, BMX, Cycle Speedway and Cyclo Cross events). Events being promoted under the auspices of British Cycling and operating under BC rules and regulations are covered by the 'Event' Public Liability Insurance Fees that are paid in advance of the event with the permit fee (where applicable and as required by BC Technical Regulations) and after the event by payment of insurance levies within 7 days. An Event Registration form must be completed and returned to British Cycling Headquarters for all events.
- ii) Cycling Time Trials (RTTC) - These Events are covered by the Insurance provided by the Road Time Trails Council / Cycling Time Trials.
- iii) Individual Club Members (as opposed to Club Officials) - Claims are not acceptable against Club Members unless they themselves are (Silver or Gold) members of British Cycling with personal liability insurance cover.

EVENT INSURANCE

All events promoted under the auspices of British Cycling are covered to an indemnity limit of £5,000,000 upon receipt of a completed Event Registration form and payment of all insurance fees where applicable. The cover indemnifies the Club, the promoter, other Officers of the Club, the event officials and the owning authority of any circuit that may have been hired, against claims for accidental bodily injury, death or accidental property damage from a Third Party.

Note : Track Meeting Promoters should note that the standard event liability insurance allows the use of derny or pacing motors. Motors are limited, however, to a maximum of 125cc and all Motor Pacers must hold a valid and appropriate British Cycling Motor Pacing licence. Drivers of motor pacing machines over 125cc must apply to British Cycling headquarters for insurance cover.

NON-COMPETITIVE SOCIAL, CHARITY & RELIABILITY RIDES

Cover can usually be made available for these events by contacting membership services on 0161 274 2010 at least a month in advance of the date of the event to obtain a quotation. An Event Registration Form must be completed and an insurance premium payment made, where applicable, before insurance cover is effective. Reliability rides restricted to members of one club or invitees are covered under the extension for Clubs shown above.
